Meeting Minutes

- 1) Introductions
- 2) Adrian Wurr summarized the history of the mural on the wall bordering UA Parking Lot 9007. He passed around pictures of the old and new murals. He described the damage to the mural, including graffiti, flaking paint, and damage due to an automobile accident, among other things. He discussed some reasons for wanting to replace the mural with a new one, mainly the damaged state of the old mural, and the fact that the old mural is HANA's responsibility. The new mural would also be an investment in the neighborhood. The new mural would be treated with a clear coating to protect it from graffiti, and would become the city's responsibility. Adrian described competing mural proposals. These are:
 - a. "Wildcat" mural designed by Artist Jodie Chertudi. This mural will cost \$20K. The money is to come from donations.
 - b. The original "Mountains" mural designed by Artist Michael Schwartz. Mr. Schwartz has offered to repair his mural at a cost of \$1,000.
 - c. A compromise proposal, which is to pay Mr. Schartz to repair the "Mountains" mural if HANA cannot get funding for the "Wildcat" mural within two months.

Attendees discussed the options. One person was concerned about the reliability of Mr. Schwartz. Another person was concerned that the cheap cost for repair of the "Mountains" mural might be due to the use of low-cost paints. A third attendee wondered if the other three "districts" in HANA might also get murals, or have other needs met. Adrian explained that the purpose of having four "districts" with four district representatives in Hedrick Acres is that the representatives could better connect with persons in their respective districts. It might be possible to rotate meetings through each district. Currently all the officers live in the same area.

A vote was held on the three mural options

- The "Wildcat" mural designed by Artist Jodie Chertudi received 9 votes.

- Repair the original “Mountains” mural designed by Artist Michael Schwartz: 3 votes.
- The compromise proposal to pay Mr. Schartz to repair the “Mountains” mural if HANA cannot get funding for the “Wildcat” mural within two months received 12 votes.

One person asked about the time frame for the work once final approval is received. Adrian said that the artist will begin work once the money is received. The timing is part of the artist’s proposal and the timing will be monitored by the Arts Foundation and the funders.

3) Neighborhood concerns

- a. Concerns were raised regarding crime on Glenn between 1st Avenue and Mountain Ave. Specifically, four houses have been robbed. There was concern about an elderly lady on the south side of Glenn who was found dead in her home, and who may have been the victim of a violent attack. However, there was no information in the news about this incident (this is not unusual).
